

TEMPORARY USE PERMIT GUIDE

Supporting business recovery after the Franklin & Palisades Fires

As part of the City's continued commitment to supporting economic recovery for businesses impacted by the 2025 Franklin and Palisades Fire, Malibu City Council has eased rules for events and sign permits.

Through **May 31, 2026**, businesses can access streamlined Temporary Use Permits (TUPs) to host events and promote services with less paperwork and shorter timelines.

TUP - Planning Clearance (TUP-PC)

For Events with Fewer than 100 Attendees

- Single-day, public events only
- No vacant suites allowed
- Onsite restrooms required (no portable restrooms)
- Apply at least 2 days before the event
- No public notice or appeal required
- Unlimited number of events allowed

TUP - Express (TUP-E)

For Events with 100 - 250 Attendees

- Single-day, public events only
- No vacant suites allowed
- Portable restrooms required
- Apply at least 7 days before the event
- Mail notices 5 days before the event
- City issues decision 3 days before
- No appeals
- Shopping centers: up to 4 per month
- Standalone tenants: up to 2 per month

Standard TUP (TUP)

For Events with 250+ Attendees

- Minimum 35-day lead time
- Follow full Temporary Use Permit process
