

PACIFIC PALISADES, CA — On Sunday, November 23 from 11:00 AM to 2:00 PM, the heart of Pacific Palisades will close its streets and open its arms to the communities of Malibu and the Palisades for the second of a series of Palibu Recovery Expo—a large-scale outdoor event showcasing over 100 exhibitors, from major companies to local nonprofits and government agencies, all focused on helping residents rebuild, recover, and thrive.

Organized by the–Malibu Pacific Palisades Chamber of Commerce (Palibu) in partnership with the Mayor's Office of Economic Recovery, the expo will stretch from Alma Real to La Cruz Drive and over to Swarthmore and Sunset, creating a lively, walkable corridor of recovery resources, demonstration booths, and community connection.
